



HOW IS THE KANSAS CITY CAMPUS FOR ANIMAL CARE BEING FUNDED?

For the first time in Kansas City's history, and thanks to the extraordinary support of 68% of the voters, the City's first official animal shelter will at last be built. Currently, the Kansas City animal shelter, operated by the remarkable KC Pet Project team, is the **one of the largest No-Kill, open admission shelters in the United States** - a staggering national statistic given the relative size of our community. Our shelter currently takes in more than 10,000 homeless, abandoned, and often injured pets each year.

First proposed by the combined vision of so many community leaders, the Kansas City Campus for Animal Care will not be just another shelter. This will be a nationally-recognized educational campus that 2.1 million residents across the Kansas City area intensely need and deserve.

Although voters overwhelmingly approved funding for construction through the City of Kansas City, Missouri, our world-class shelter building and animal care campus was designed to be built through public and private partnerships.

PUBLIC SECTOR SUPPORT

Voters showed overwhelming support for a new animal shelter during the April 2017 election contributing \$14 million towards initial building construction. The City will contribute an additional \$4 million from bond proceeds for total public sector support of \$18 million.

PRIVATE SECTOR SUPPORT

The total cost of the **53,960 square foot shelter will be \$28 million**, making **the total private sector commitment \$12 million** (plus a targeted future \$5 million endowment to ensure life-saving programs will be sustained for many years ahead).
